Stephen Spinelli, Jr. is the Chancellor of Thomas Jefferson University (TJU) appointed at the merger of Philadelphia University and Thomas Jefferson University. Dr. Spinelli became president of Philadelphia University on September 1, 2007. He has many years of leadership experience in academia, business and philanthropy. Under his leadership, Philadelphia University has become the model for professional university education. As part of the University's bold Strategic Plan, Dr. Spinelli led the way in formalizing the University's signature approach to education, Nexus Learning. It is transdisciplinary, active, and real-world learning that is infused with the liberal arts. In 2010, Philadelphia University created the award-winning Kanbar College of Design, Engineering and Commerce to teach innovation and collaboration in the design, engineering, and business majors. Dr. Spinelli has also led the University's most successful capital campaign in its history.

Dr. Spinelli currently serves on the Board of Advisors for the Berwind Corporation and the Chairman of the Board of Planet Fitness. Previously, Dr. Spinelli was co-founder of Jiffy Lube International and Chairman and CEO of the American Oil Change Corporation, helping to pioneer the quick lube industry nationwide and turning Jiffy Lube into the nation's dominant competitor with more than 1,000 service centers.
